All applications must contain: a complete application cover sheet, a brief description of what the funds will be used for, and an itemization of estimated expenses. The award maximum is generally \$2,000, but larger amounts will be considered. After the funds have been put to use, you should submit a one page report on what they helped you accomplish.
